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Consent for Electronic Communication

Consent to Send/Receive Protected Health Information (PHI) by Non-Encrypted E-mail and/or via text message

Judson Center offers consumers of services the ability to receive PHI via non-encrypted electronic mail (e-mail) or via text message for non-urgent matters. Per HIPAA, consumers of health care services have the right to request information in alternate forms, email and text message are alternates to US mail or telephonic communication.

No information will be sent electronically without permission given by you or your legally authorized representative.

Judson Center cannot and does not guarantee the privacy or security of any messages being sent over the Internet:

There is the potential that non-encrypted e-mail sent over the Internet or a text message can be intercepted and read by others. If this is of concern to you, you should not communicate with Judson Center through e-mail or a text message.

Authorization to use e-mail and/or text messaging:
